FOR CHILDREN BIRTH TO SIX

- Is your child overly demanding, cry often, or cling to you?
- Does your child get upset easily or have difficulty calming down once upset?
- Is your child frequently sad or unhappy?
- Does your child hit others or throw temper tantrums more than what seems typical?
- Does your child seem more angry or disobedient than other children?
- Is your child a challenge at day care?
- Is your child highly active or have difficulty sticking with tasks?

SERVICES AVAILABLE

- Access to services such as full evaluation, case management, family therapy, play therapy, parent support
- Treatment of trauma related issues in children
- Specialized Services:
- Parent Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT)
- Child Parent Psychotherapy (CPP)
- Circle of Security Parenting groups
- "Holding Hope" pregnancy / postpartum peer support
- Parents and Babies Intervention (group or 1:1)
- Assistance connecting parents with perinatal mental health concerns to resources

A RANGE OF SERVICES

- Coordinated, seamless care with other CIS providers, such as CIS Family Support workers, Early Intervention, Nursing.
- Services can provide preventative counseling for parent & child to strengthen relationships.
- Transitional services to care after age six.
- · Help with kindergarten readiness.
- Consultation to child care programs available.
